Do you have a claim?

You might not be sure whether you have a claim. You might think the accident was your fault, or partly your fault, or was just too long ago to count? Please ask one of our experts.

If your injury was caused by an accident that was not your fault, you will be entitled to claim compensation. You can also claim even when you know the accident was partly your fault. This is called contributory negligence. You can still claim compensation, but the amount is reduced to allow for the fact it was partly your negligence. Often people don't claim because they think it's too late, but in most cases you have up to three years after the accident and longer in the case of children and people with a disability.
